The capital of the Roman Empire and home to both Jewish and Gentile Christians (1:7). Paul longed to see and strengthen the Roman churches and be supported by them, before travelling onto Spain (1:9-15; 15:23-24).

Corinth ☆

Paul probably wrote to the Roman churches from Corinth on his third missionary journey (see Acts 20:2). The letter was most likely delivered by Phoebe (mentioned in 16:1-2).

Spain ☆

After travelling to Jerusalem and Rome, Paul planned to take the gospel to the unreached region of Spain. (15:24, 28) No such visit, though, is recorded in the New Testament.
